#ABAforAll Golf Tournament: 4-Ball Scramble Rules

Welcome to the Lake Ridge Community Support Services #ABAforAll 4-Ball Scramble! We're thrilled to have you participate in this exciting golf event. Below are the rules and guidelines for the tournament:

Format:

- The tournament will be played using the 4-Ball Scramble format. Each team consists of four players.
- All players in a team will hit their tee shots. After reviewing the results, the team will select the best tee shot. All players will then play their next shots from the location of the selected best tee shot within golf club length.
- This process continues for each shot until the ball is holed out.
- For shots on the green, each player must play within a putter's head of where the ball came to rest.
- The team records the best score achieved for each shot throughout the round.

Tee Times:

- Each foursome will have a designated tee time. Please arrive at the course at least 30 minutes before your scheduled tee time to ensure a smooth start.
- Tee times will start at 10:30 AM

Scoring:

The winner will be determined by the lowest score.

Rules:

- All players must adhere to the rules and etiquette of golf as outlined by the <u>USGA</u> to the best of there abilities while adhering to the format above.
- Mulligans and extra shots are not allowed unless purchased from tournament organizers and volunteers. Each shot counts towards the team's score.
- Players must play from the designated tee boxes for their skill level and gender.
- In case of lost balls or out-of-bounds shots, the team must play the ball from the original spot and add a penalty stroke to their score.

Winners:

- The winning team will be announced once all scorecards have been collected, reviewed, and verified.
- Prizes will be awarded to the top-performing teams based on their net scores.
- In case of a tie, a tiebreaker system will be implemented to determine the final winner.
- If the tying players have the same score the winner will be determined based on the score for the last nine holes, last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole.

Prizes and Awards:

- Prizes will be awarded to the winning team, as well as potentially for longest drive, closest to the pin, and the putting contest.
- Prizes will be presented to the winners either at the tournaments conclusion or a date when all parties can be available.

Scorecards:

- Each team will receive a scorecard before their tee time. Please keep track of your team's strokes and scores accurately on the scorecard during the round.
- After completing the round, ensure that the scorecard is signed by all players in the team and that the scores are totaled correctly.
