
## Trick or Treat!






Halloween is a holiday that is on October 31st.





On the night of Halloween, I will go trick-or-treating.




It is a tradition for kids and adults to dress up on Halloween. I will be wearing a costume. Other people will be wearing costumes too.



I will walk around my neighborhood with an adult. I need to make sure I have a bucket or container for candy.




I will walk up to someone's front door and knock. When they open the door, I will say "trick or treat".




They will give me some candy to put inside of my bucket. When they give me candy, I will say "thank you".






I will walk with an adult to the next house and repeat these steps!
