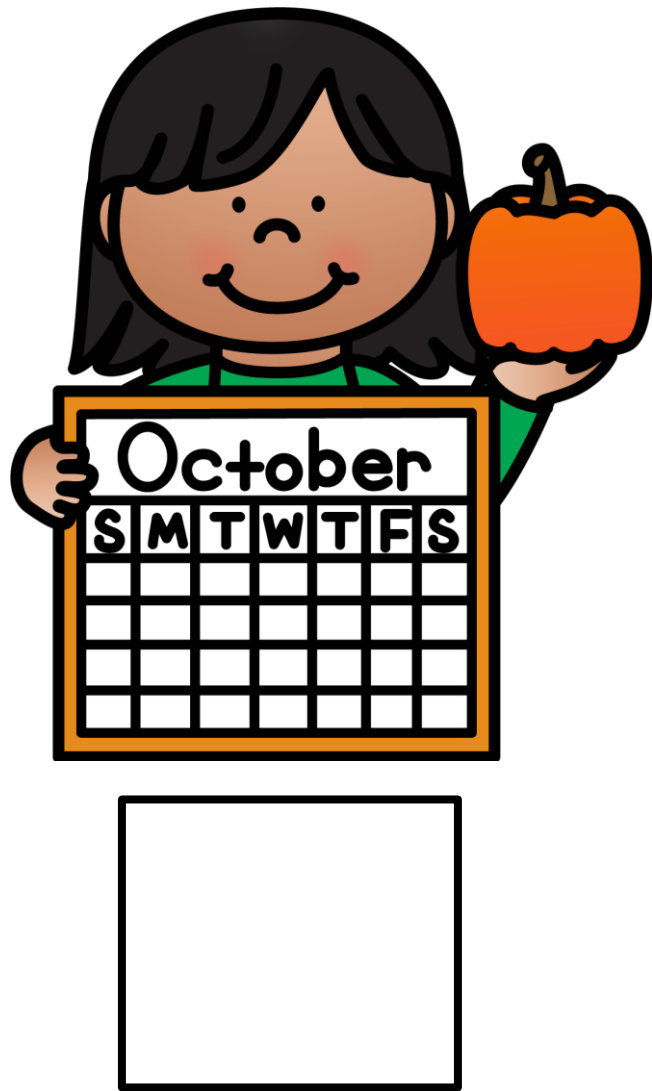


# Trick or Treat!

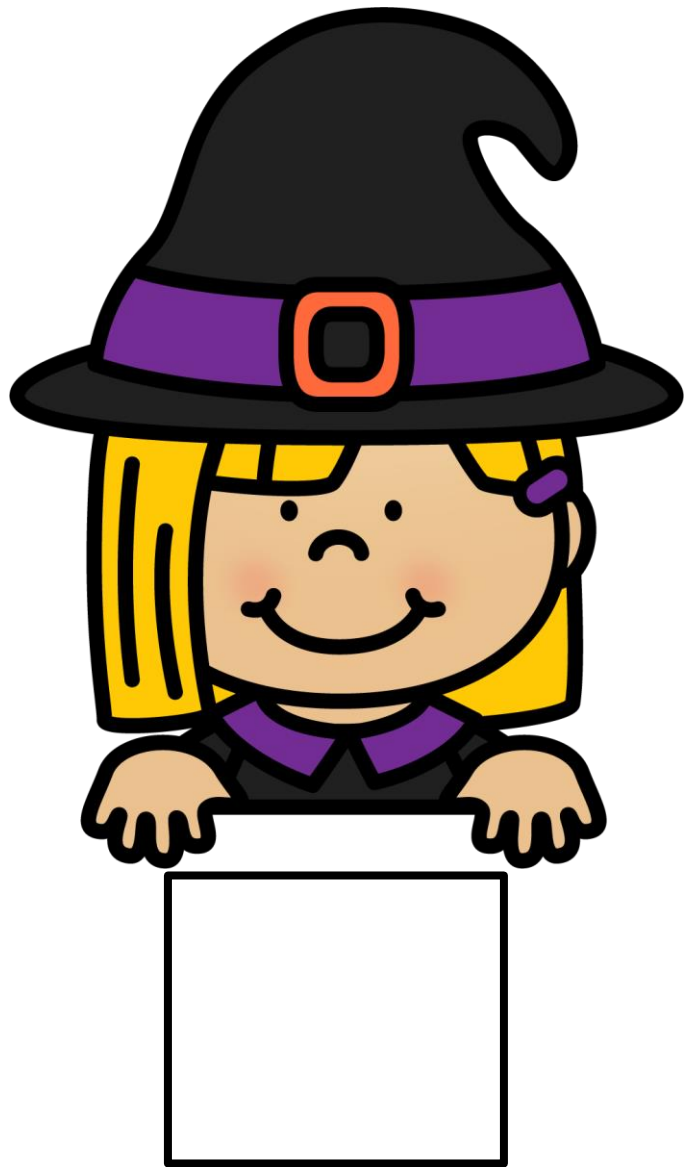
Halloween is a holiday that is on
